Base in ground pool opening: \$420 (All size pools) (#12000)

Includes:

- Remove, fold and roll of the cover
- Remove winter hardware
- Install in-season hardware (excludes diving boards)
- Spray debris off of deck
- Assemble/reassemble filter
- Startup of system
- check for proper operation
- Add initial dose of shock
- All other chemicals are **NOT** included

Includes second/follow up visit which includes:

- Cleaning the filter
- Full vacuum of pool
- Follow up visit roughly 1 week after opening, up to 1 hour
- Time past 1 hour is additional charge of \$45 per half hour (#12022)
- Customer must add water between opening and return visit if water level is too low

Base above ground opening: \$300 (Sizes 12'-24" round, 12'x17-15'x30' oval) (#12001) \$350 (Sizes 27' round, 16'x32' oval and larger) (#12002)

Includes:

- Remove, fold and roll of the cover
- Remove winter hardware
- Install in-season hardware
 - Ladders (must have ladder mat)
 - Walk in steps – see below
- Assemble/reassemble filter
- Startup of system
- check for proper operation
- Add initial dose of shock
- All other chemicals are **NOT** included

Includes second/follow up visit which includes:

- Cleaning the filter
- Full vacuum of pool
- Follow up visit roughly 1 week after opening, up to 1 hour
- Time past 1 hour is additional charge of \$45 per half hour (#12022)
- Customer must add water between opening and return visit if water level is too low

Add on/extra charges for Openings:

- Additional \$3/mile, one way, after first 25 miles, from the closest starting location - Amherst NH store or Lowell MA service location (#12021)
- \$25 Install drop in steps that require a weight (#12003)
- \$50 per additional feature (Spa/in floor cleaners/waterfall clean ups/cable systems/solar systems/etc.) (#12004)
- \$90/hour to remove water and debris from solid covers that are not cleared off (#12022)
- \$25 to remove old covers/old equipment (#12027)
- Specific upcharges for difficult or complicated pools to be determined by technician

Base in ground pool closing: \$350 (#12007)

Includes:

- Drain water to appropriate level
- Install cover (Safety or solid with water bags)
- Blowing out lines
 - Using gas compressor
 - Single pump systems
 - Additional pumps – see below
- Cleaning of the filter (cart. or DE)
- Remove in season hardware
- Install winter hardware
- Add anti-freeze (when necessary)
- All other chemicals are NOT included
- Pool must be clear for service
 - If pool requires cleaning, the one-time cleaning fee will apply

Base above ground closing: \$160 (sizes 12'-24' round, 12'x27' – 15'x30' oval) (#12008) \$200 (sizes 27'+ round, 16'x32' oval and larger) (#12009)

Includes:

- Drain water to appropriate level
- Install cover (Must be sized properly 5' to 7' bigger than pool)
- Winterization of equipment
- Remove in season hardware
 - Ladders
 - Walk in steps – see below
- Install winter hardware
- Inflate ice equalizer pillow(s)
- Cleaning of the filter (cart. or DE)
- All other chemicals are NOT included
- Pool must be clear for service
 - If pool requires cleaning, the one-time cleaning fee will apply

Blow out lines only: \$175 (see below for extras) (#12010)

- Blow out return, skimmer and main drain lines for winterization of in ground pools
- Water must be drained ahead of time to winter level and winter plugs accessible.
- Add anti-freeze (when necessary)
- 1 pump system pools only, if more features, see added charges below

Add on/extra charges for Closings:

- Additional \$3/mile, one way, after first 25 miles, from the closest starting location - Amherst NH store or Lowell MA service location (#12021)
- \$50 per additional feature (Spa/in floor cleaners/cable systems/solar systems/etc.) (#12004)
- \$25 cleaning of additional filter (#12012)
- \$15 add secondary attachment method (cover clips/wrap/leaf nets/etc.) (#12013)
- \$25 blowout main drain line on above ground pools (#12014)

Weekly maintenance: \$85 per week (#12015), \$110 every two weeks (#12016)

Includes (weekly and every two weeks):

 - Using customer's chemicals FIRST
 - Supplied chemicals added to invoice
- Filter cleaning (when needed)
- Emptying of cleaner bags
- Emptying of skimmer and pump baskets
- Photo documentation of serviced pool
- Maintenance is roughly 40 minutes a week
 - Minimum of 30 minutes
 - Maximum of 1 hour
- Pool must be clear to start

One Time Pool Cleaning: \$120 an hour (#12019) (For pools that 'slipped away' or went green/cloudy)

Includes:

- Vacuuming
- Skimming
- Chemical testing
- Brushing
- Filter cleaning (when needed)
- Emptying of cleaner bags
- Emptying of skimmer and pump baskets
- Chemical adjustments and additions
 - Using customer's chemicals FIRST
 - Supplied chemicals added to invoice
- Photo documentation of serviced pool
- No Pre-Service inspection required

Add on/extra charges for Weekly Maintenance:

- Job locations 26-35 miles from starting location, add \$10 (#12017). Job locations 36+ miles from starting location add \$25 (#12018). From closest starting location - Amherst NH store or Lowell MA service location
- \$45/half hour, minimum half hour, if excessive debris cleaning goes over included hour (#12022)
- \$25 to remove old covers/old equipment (#12027)
- Chemicals from our stock will be billed additionally to customer
- Specific upcharges for difficult or complicated pools – determined by technician

Bi-Weekly or Monthly Maintenance: \$100 per visit (#12029)

Includes:

- Skimming
- Brushing (if needed)
- Chemical testing
- Chemical adjustments and additions
 - Using customer's chemicals FIRST
 - Supplied chemicals added to invoice
- Filter cleaning (rinsed if needed)
- Photo documentation of serviced pool
- Check over of equipment/operation
- Maintenance is roughly 30 minutes a visit
 - Minimum of 20 minutes
 - Maximum of 45 minutes
- Spa must be running and full to start

Spa Drain and Clean: \$250 (#XXXXX) \$200 for Spa purchased at Seasonal (12028)

Includes:

- Run Serum through system
- Draining of water
 - Designated area needs to be available
- Cleaning of spa surface
- Chemical filter cleaning
- Refilling of spa
- Chemical testing
- Chemical adjustments and additions
 - Using customer's chemicals FIRST
 - Supplied chemicals added to invoice
- Photo documentation of serviced pool
- Spa must be running and full to start

Add on/extra charges for Spa Service:

- Job locations 26-35 miles from starting location, add \$10 (#12017). Job locations 36+ miles from starting location add \$25 (#12018). From Amherst NH store location.
- Chemicals from our stock will be billed additionally to customer
- Swim spas, or spas over 500 gallons, see service manager for pricing
- Specific upcharges for difficult or complicated spas – determined by technician

Spa Repairs: \$140 per hour (#6610)

- On most major brands
- One hour minimum, starting when technician leaves the Amherst NH store location
- Only \$90 per hour if you purchased the hot tub from us (#6587)
